New Business:

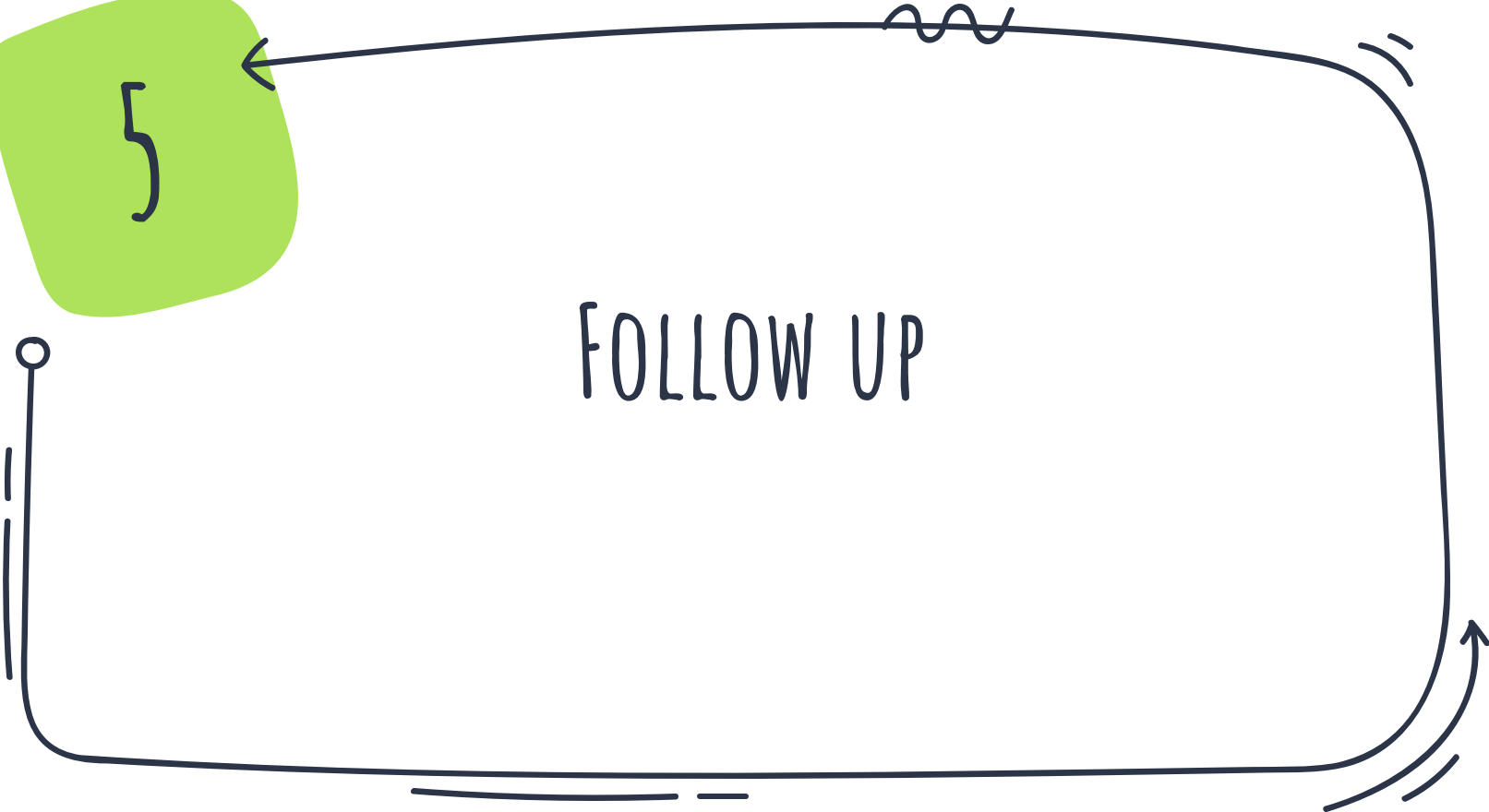
- Host a mentor thank you event in January for our mentors to check in and see what they need
